- --Men's Group: Enjoying Christian fellowship and great dinners, every fourth Tuesday @ 6:30pm. Bring a friend!
- --Methodist Men's Breakfast: Starting this Wednesday at 7am, great Christian fellowship, devotional, and mission focus. All men are invited.
- --**UMYF**: our new youth fellowship that meets every first and third Wednesday at 6:30pm.
- --Community Table: our outreach to the Monroe community through a no-cost meal and Christian fellowship, including music jam. And weren't those tacos fantastic!
- --Weekly Bible Study: meets every Tuesday @ 9am. Currently exploring the Letter of James.
- --Chimes: meets nearly every week to provide uplifting music during worship.
- --Choir: provides inspiring songs for every worship, practice is Sunday mornings prior to worship. If you can sing, don't hide it beneath a bushel.
- --VIP: gifted women who add to our worship with special musical selections.
- --Banner Gild: amazingly talented women who fashion our fantastic liturgical banners.
- --175th Anniversary Committee: meets regularly to develop a host of programs designed to celebrate 175 years of faith as a church, with special programs each month of 2019.
- --Seasonal Celebrations: Turkey Supper, Ice Cream Social, UMW Bazaar, Old Settlers Pancake Breakfast, proceeds going to various church-supported Christian missions.
- --VBS: annually observed with our Presbyterian neighbors (our turn this year, more to come).
- --Summer Church Camp: devoted to growing Christians while having a bunch of fun!
- --Cub Scouts: meet the last Sunday of each month at 6:30pm, promoting mental, physical, and spiritual strength.
- --Blood Drive: hosting periodic drives (next one is 11 May, beginning 6:30am).
- --Alcoholics Anonymous: meets every Monday night at 7pm, devoted to a sober life.
- --Church Council: our overarching council comprised of a variety of committees and boards that strategize for ministry and tend to the general administration of the church (by the way, administration has Latin roots, which literally means "for a lesser service," in other words, in service to a superior, which for us is Christ), meets every other month (22 May @7pm).
- --Worship: last, but certainly not least, every Sunday at 9:30. Bring a friend!

While this doesn't exhaust the list, I pray you consider ways of being involved as we live the truth of Easter through the ministry of our church. Truly, if God is for us, who is against us?


